

## UW Medicine Ambulatory Quality Definitions FY19

### Cancer Screening

- Breast Cancer Screening
  - Women 52-74: Mammogram in past 24 months
- Cervical Cancer Screening
  - Women 24-64: Pap or HPV in past 3y
  - Women 35-64: Pap + HPV co-testing in past 5y
- Colorectal Cancer Screening
  - Patients 51-75: Colonoscopy in past 10 years or flex sig in past 5 years or FIT in past 12 months

### Immunizations

- Childhood Immunization Status
  - Patients 24-36 months old on visit date
  - Must have all: DTaP (4), IPV (3), MMR (1), HIB (3), HepB (3), VZV (1), PCV (4), Hep A (1), RV (2), Flu (2)
- Pneumonia Vaccination
  - Patients  $\geq 67$ : Pneumovax or Prevnar

### Diabetes

- Patients 19-75: A1c test in past 12 months and  $A1c \leq 9.0$
- Eye Exam: Retinal exam within past 12 months

### Blood Pressure

- If diabetic, patients 19-75: Blood pressure  $<140$  and  $<90$
- If not diabetic:
  - Age 19-59: Blood pressure  $<140$  and  $<90$
  - Age 60-85: Blood pressure  $<150$  and  $<90$
- Exclusion: pregnancy in past 12 months, ESRD, renal transplant

### Depression

- Patients  $\geq 18$  with billed diagnosis of depression or dysthymia
  - PHQ-9 within past 3 months
  - Exclusion: bipolar, personality disorder

### Chlamydia

- Women age 16-24 and sexually active (subgroups 16-20, 21-24)
  - Chlamydia test within past 12 months
